



Fort Leavenworth Hunt Guest & Capping Policy

FLH encourages members to invite guests to hunt with us. We do not limit the number of Caps a non-member may have in each Hunt season. Our Capping Fees and Policy are as follows:

All first time (new to foxhunting) riders with the Fort Leavenworth Hunt: FLH will waive the capping fee for the first 2 rides. The third visit will require a cap. Return visits in subsequent years will require a capping fee.

FLH alumni/former members, Social Members, or guests from other Hunts: FLH does not limit the number of times you may Cap. FLH Alumni should not wear their Colors unless a Master has invited them to do so.

Cost: All guests brought to any FLH scheduled Hunt will pay a Cap of \$75.00 per person/family (2 or more family members) based on stated conditions above.

If you, as a member of FLH, wish to bring a Guest; you should:

- a. Contact ahead of time a Joint Master or Secretary to let them know that you are bringing a guest. Also, during your conversation, let the contacted Master or Secretary know the individual's riding ability or membership with another Hunt so we are aware of the riding level and we can advise you if there will be adequate Staff to accommodate your guest's riding level.
- b. Request a Hold Harmless be sent to you via email or mall so the person will be prepared to read and sign the Hold Harmless on the day of the Hunt. NOTE: Junior (under the age of 18 yrs.) guests must have a legal parent or guardian present at the day's Hunt to read and sign the Hold Harmless.
- c. On the day of the Hunt, arrive EARLY. Immediately seek out the Honorary Secretary or a Master (if the Honorary Secretary is not in attendance). Present your guest (and the parent as it applies to a Junior) to the Honorary Secretary or Master so the guest or legal guardian of the Junior can read and sign the Hold Harmless in the presence of the Honorary Secretary or Master.
- d. Please have in a white envelope, marked with the words "Honorary Secretary", a check made out to FLH/FMWR for \$50.00 per person/family (2 or more family members).
- e. You should instruct your guest in Hunting etiquette, safety procedures and proper attire.
- f. You should ride with your guest and their mount in the Field they are best suited for. Safety is paramount!

Currently there is a reciprocal agreement between Mission Valley Hunt and FLH. MVH members are welcome to hunt with us and not pay a cap. FLH members must contact an FLH Joint Master before they go to a Mission Valley Hunt fixture to ensure it is a convenient time to be hosted.
